

There are instructions to guide you through the process of weaving Celtic knots. Use the knots to embellish table linens, guilts, and clothing.

He learned the operations of symmetry and developed a method for generating patchwork patterns of interlocking shapes known as tessellations, which he has demonstrated on TV and taught online.
